**WipeOut** – In case of phone loss, the user can choose to remotely wipe out all private data contained in the device. All messages, photographs, contacts and even the entire memory card may be deleted, thus ensuring complete privacy.

WaveSecure can be easily installed on mobile phones running the popular Windows Mobile or Symbian operating systems. Supporting many of the leading mobile phone brands and models, the software communicates with the WaveSecure website using a combination of wireless internet (WiFi), GPRS/3G and encrypted SMS technology.

In addition to achieving the highest international standards, WaveSecure is also certified safe by Thawte, Inc., a leading security certification provider in the United States.

WaveSecure is currently available for a three-month trial by invitation only from its website at [www.wavesecure.com](http://www.wavesecure.com). Interested consumers may request for an invitation code from tenCube. The service is completely free during the trial period. Pricing will be kept reasonable at the end of the trial to ensure that this service remains affordable to consumers.
